Gleaning time is almost here. I will have e-mails sent out when there is gleaning to be done for the Society of St. Andrew. If you can help in this way to provide food for the hungry, it would be appreciated.

If you are interested in driving once a month for Faith in Action to take people to doctor's appointments, etc., call 540-536-1006. If you are 55 or over, they ask that you take an AARP driver's safety course. It is a one or two day course with no test. The certificate is good for three years and will qualify you for a deduction on your automobile insurance. Call me or watch the newspaper to sign up for courses.

C-Cap can always use volunteers. A crew from Market Street volunteers on Wednesdays.

I recently talked with a young man who is "one fire for Christ" and wants to share Jesus Christ and God's grace with others. He will be teaching an Arab country through Campus Crusade for Christ. They have no funds for paying salaries and ministry expenses. They depend upon financial support from concerned individuals and churches.
